[Green Healthcare Leadership Programme](#)

A bespoke leadership development programme for nurses to lead a sustainable healthcare project. Participants will develop personal leadership attributes, political acumen, and influencing skills. The programme is delivered in 9 days spread over 9 months, including a residential and presenting quality improvement (QI) projects to a VIP audience.

This module will introduce students to the reciprocal relationships between climate change, health and healthcare, including discussions of interventions for tackling issues at this intersection. Students will develop a global perspective on health care and climate change and apply their learning to develop, implement, and evaluate interventions to deliver sustainable health care. The module is delivered over 7-9 weeks, including a week in Oxford for face-to-face teaching.

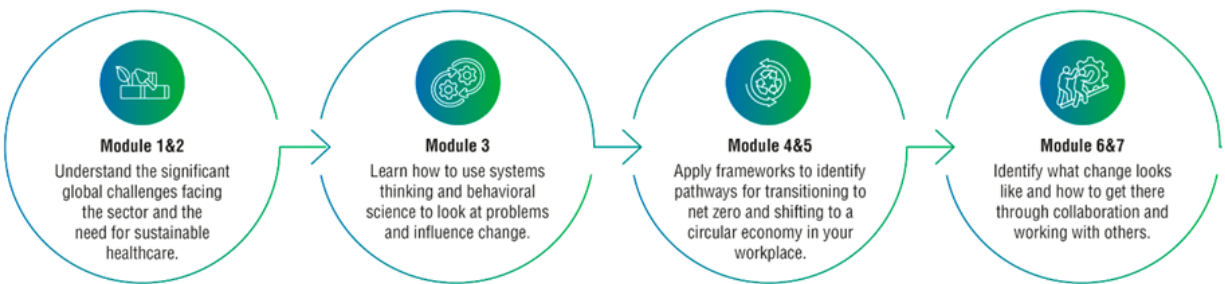
